

DIRECTIONS BY CAR

From I-95

Southbound: Take exit 47 for I-91 North in New Haven; follow directions below. *Northbound*: Take exit 48 for I-91 North in New Haven (left exit); follow directions below.

From I-91

Take Exit 3 off I-91 (from North or South). The exit ramp becomes Trumbull Street. Follow Trumbull to the fifth stoplight and take a left onto Prospect Street.

Continue straight onto College Street

Take the first right onto Wall Street.

After passing High Street, the Law School will be on the right.

From the Merritt Parkway:

Take exit 59 for New Haven/Woodbridge.

Turn right onto Whalley Avenue and continue until it merges with Elm Street.

Turn left onto College Street.

Turn left onto Wall Street.

(Alternatively, you may take a left from Elm Street onto York Street, which borders the Law School to the west).

PARKING

On street metered parking is available on York and Grove Streets and on other streets in the vicinity; the main entrance to the Law School (127 Wall Street) is closest to the corner of Wall and High Streets. Parking on Wall Street is by permit only. Public parking for a fee is also available in the lot at Broadway and Elm Streets.

After 4:00 p.m., visitors may park for free in Yale Lot 16 (Whitney Avenue and Humphrey Street) or Yale Lot 37 (on Trumbull Street between Temple and Hillhouse).
