A multi-disciplinary research team at Y-RISE led by Professor Mushfiq Mobarak is conducting high-frequency phone-based surveys and running experimental and non-experimental evaluations to support policymakers in Bangladesh, Nepal, Nigeria, and Sierra Leone develop evidence-based policy responses to contain the COVID-19 crisis. In the coming months, several research outputs will be published with the intent of guiding policy makers to devise effective response strategies. Y-RISE is seeking a summer intern to support Y-RISE's policy outreach activities in light of this work.
